



40. The Narrow Gate

Jesus said, *“Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life,”* Matthew 7:13-14.

And Jesus said, *“I am the door of the sheep ... if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture,”* John 10:7-9. The way to God is very narrow ...
